## **Position Summary**

Lead 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students into safe, age-appropriate, irresistible and transformational services. Our Edge 56 lead will oversee weekend services, life groups, special events and camps. The Edge 56 Lead will champion church for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders.

## **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

- Curriculum planning and preparation for Sunday services and Wednesday night Edge 56 life groups (6 Hours)
  - Research, evaluate and write and/or select preteen curriculum for Sunday services and Wednesday life groups.
  - o Edit purchased material to fit our Journey DNA
  - o Print and prepare weekly mid-week handouts
  - Send a monthly schedule to each service area with assigned volunteer leadership positions.
  - Work with weekend teachers to write and teach in Edge 56 according to the Bible series
  - Send a weekly team e-mail with the curriculum and important information to help prepare volunteers for their life groups.
  - o Include creative age-appropriate activities, games and crafts to help build community and enhance the learning environment
- Preparation for Sunday services (5 hours)
  - Work with the Journey Kids Admin to gather, purchase and prepare all materials and supplies for the service and the Edge 56 Café
  - o Communicate, train equip and work with volunteer table leaders
  - o Set up Edge 56 room including series decorations, lesson materials and handouts
  - o Ensure worship team is scheduled
  - o Ensure media is updated and loaded for the weekend
  - Clean up following the service and replace supplies
  - Communicate through Journey Connect, the Weekly Update and FaceBook information to parents, students and leaders

- Preparation for Wednesday night life groups (4 hours)
  - Work with the Resource Coordinator to gather, purchase and prepare all materials and supplies for life groups
  - o Communicate, train, equip, and work with life group leaders
  - Set up Edge 56 room for life groups
  - Coordinate with the Student Min team to coordinate Wednesday Night Food and overall campus set up.
  - o Ensure worship team is scheduled and prepared when needed
  - o Ensure media is updated and loaded
  - Clean up following life groups and replace supplies
  - o Communicate through Journey Connect, the Weekly Update and FaceBook information to parents, students and leaders
- Plan and implement special events for Edge 56 including: (4 hours more as needed)
  - o Edge 56 Summer Camp
  - Easter Services & Christmas Eve Services
  - o Edge 56 Winter Day Camp
  - o Other Special Events as needed
  - o Communicate through Journey Connect, the Weekly Update and FaceBook information to parents, students and leaders
  - Partnering with Riptide on occasional middle school events and In-The-Middle Services
- Volunteers (4 hours)
  - o Invite others to be part of Edge 56
  - o Meet with every leader a minimum once a year one-one to get feedback and help build the team by building relationships with each leader
  - o Actively seek out volunteers to join the Kids Ministry Team
  - o Staff Sunday services and Wednesday life groups with volunteers
  - Keep track of a master volunteer schedule and send out weekly through Planning Center for each area of Edge 56
  - o Find replacement volunteers for last minute gaps in schedule
  - o Keep Journey Connect updated by group with volunteer information & photo
  - Ensure background checks are completed
- Training & Development (2 hours)
  - Provide group training for staff and all new volunteers including going over the Kids Ministry General Policies and Procedures, position descriptions and any age specific information that can help a leader connect with students and parents.
- Team and Relationship Building (1 hour)
  - Connect with and support volunteers
  - o Encourage them with notes, gifts, e-mails, texts etc.
  - o Pray for and with volunteers

o Conduct appreciation events with each volunteer team and then one large gathering once a year.
